

# Advanced Fire Fighting Training

## Course aim:

The course will provide delegates with a sufficient level of knowledge and confidence to allow them to contribute effectively and safely as Fire Fighting Training Co-ordinators /Team Leaders

## Duration:

This is a four day course.

## Accommodation:

## Entry Qualifications:

Delegates will be required to have previous sea going and fire fighting training, including the use of self contained breathing apparatus. Delegates should be reasonably fit.

- Theory of combustion
- Fire behaviour, fire prevention & classification of fire
- Control & extinction of fires
- Fire fighting organisation
- Incident command, control & communication techniques
- Compartment fire fighting techniques
- The containment of fire
- Machinery space fire fighting
- Classification of ships structure
- Fire detection equipment and investigation
- Legislation
- Liaison with Fire & Rescue services
- Ship stability
- Search & rescue techniques
- Use & control of breathing apparatus
- Major incident involving multi-compartment fire fighting and search and rescue scenarios

## Qualifications gained:

Delegates who successfully complete the course will be awarded an MCA Accredited Advanced Fire Fighting certificate in accordance with MCA certified guidelines A-V1/3 as part of the STCW '95 code.
