

Rating Forming Part of a Navigational Watch

Course aim

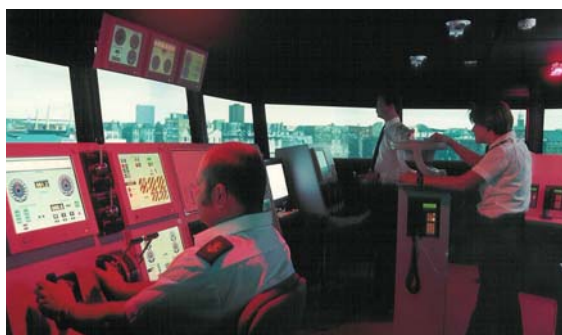
This course will provide the shore based requirements for Ratings forming part of a Navigation Watch and to prepare Deck ratings for the sea based stage of their training.

Duration

This is a five day course.

Accommodation

We can arrange single en-suite accommodation with breakfast, plus transport to and from the training facility each day for £35 per person per night.



Who should attend

This course is aimed at new seafarers.

Course content

- Steering and helm orders
- Contributing to monitoring and controlling a safe watch
- Lookout duties
- Operating emergency equipment

Entry qualifications

- STCW 95 A-VI/1 (para 2.1.4) Personal Safety and Social Responsibilities
- STCW 95 A-VI/1-1 Personal Survival Techniques
- STCW 95 A-VI/1-2 Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting
- STCW 95 A-VI/1-3 Elementary First Aid

Qualifications gained

Delegates who successfully complete the course will be awarded a certificate for Ratings forming part of a Navigational Watch. This is subject to being over 17 years of age, having completed 6 months approved sea service and successful completion of all 4 elements of the STCW95 Basic Sea Safety Certificate.
